Unlock Together options include:



Learning Labs

Individuals or teams participate in a series of sessions related to key Unlock concepts (productivity, communications, culture) or more in-depth learning centered on neuroscience, chronobiology, attention retention, information psychology, and productive habits.



Unlock Academy

Offered by-invitation within an organization or to individuals who apply to open sessions, the Academy provides an elite development opportunity over an extended time (typically 2 to 4 months). Content is built upon the Unlock methodology and flexes to meet the needs and development of the cohort. An online community allows for additional, asynchronous connection.



Unlock On Demand

Videos and material can be available for asynchronous access to the Unlock concepts. This option is offered in addition to other elements or as a standalone resource for groups who want to revisit or access Unlock on their timetable.



Offsites

Deep dive learning is incorporated into existing events, such as team offsites, employee/student onboarding programs, industry group conferences, and professional development programs.



Unlock Retreats

For those wanting an in-depth experience, these immersive events blend broad learning with personalized action planning on how, where, and what is needed to do fewer things better...starting now.



Pop-Up Unlock Sessions

Several times a year, Unlock offers limited-seat events that are open to all. Recent sessions have been on "Hack Your Productivity" (hosted by Microsoft) and "How to Be Heard in a Noisy World."

While there is never an off-the-shelf solution that works for everyone, the benefit of learning together is the ability to test-and-learn in a collaborative environment.
